All- in- one solitaire program

By Andie Francese The term Solitaire refers to a series of one-person card games that require concentration and strategic thinking to win. First popular in the early 1800s in France, solitaire moved into England and the United States in the later part of the 1800s. In 1990, the first computer solitaire game appeared as part of the Windows 3.0 operating system, and some version of the game has been included on computers ever since. MobilityWare's basic solitaire program, designed for iPhone and iPad, brings classic gaming to mobile devices without changing anything. You won't find great graphics or catchy music in this app, but people who want a simplistic gaming experience can download Solitaire from the iTunes Store through their device (See Resources).
